Statutes relating to the establishment of Late Sri D. Devaraja Urs Chair in the University, framed under section 35(n) of Karnataka State Universities Act, 1976.

Amendment to IV(A) (3) of the Statute relating to Sri D. Devaraja Urs Chair.

These statutes shall be called Amendment Statute relating to Sri D. Devaraja Urs Chair (2001).

Title and Commencement.

1. These Statutes shall be called "Statutes relating to the establishment of a Chair in the name of late Sri D. Devaraja Urs, former Chief Minister of Karnataka.
2. These Statutes shall come into effect from the date of assent of the Chancellor.

Location:

This Chair be located in the Institute of Development Studies, Manasagangothri, Mysore.

Objectives:

- The object of establishing the Chair is to have an in-depth study on the developmental programmes chalked out by the State Government which are meant for the welfare of the SCs, and STs and other Backward Classes in the State.
- To analyse the impact on the Society of the Legislative measures such as land reforms, debt liquidation and abolition of bonded labour.
- To investigate the impact of the policy of reservation, the leakages that occur in the delivery of the benefit of such reservations to SCs, STs and other backward classes in the State and to recommend to the Government of Karnataka for any changes in that direction.
- To collect data with regards the percentage of actual beneficiaries of reservation in the field of education and administration from time to time and to assess on that basis the progress made.

IV Staff.

(A) Visiting Professor:

1. There shall be a Visiting Professor, who shall be appointed by invitation by the Syndicate for a period of not less than 3 months and not exceeding 6 months during the academic year.
 2. Visiting Professor shall be selected from amongst eminent (Scholars) in the field of Development Studies or Sociology or Social Anthropology or Economics or Law or Political Science or any "eminent literature" who is committed to social upliftment of the masses and who has done considerable writings in the field may be considered for this post.
- Visiting Professor shall be eligible for an honorarium of Rs.8,000=00 p.m. He / she shall be provided with free accommodation in the University Guest House. Reimbursement of travel expenses shall be limited to journey at the time of joining and that of returning to home town on the expiry of the term.

(B) Research Fellows:

1. In order to maintain the uninterrupted continuity of the activities and the continuity of the Chair, there shall be 2 Research Fellows appointed for the Chair at any given time.
2. They shall be paid fellowship on par with the University Research Fellows and conditions of their appointment shall also be in accordance with the University Research Fellows. However, their tenure of appointment shall be initially for two years which can be extended by 1 or 2 more year(s). They shall be appointed by the Vice-Chancellor.
3. The Research Fellows, shall be appointed from among candidates possessing Post-Graduation in the subjects stipulated under para IV(2) of these Statutes.
4. Their duties and responsibilities are to collect data required, conduct research in the concerned field and help the Visiting Professor in his / her functions that are assigned to by these Statutes, so as to achieve the objectives covered in these Statutes.

V. Scope:

1. Holding lectures (not less than 2 in a month) by the Visiting Professor on the objectives stipulated in these Statutes.
2. Bringing out publications in the style of "Sri D. Devaraja Urs Memorial Lectures covering the lectures of the Visiting Professor".
3. Conducting Seminars, Workshops, Study Circles to formulate the objectives of these Statutes.

VI Finance:

1. The State Government have deposited with the University during 1966 a sum of Rs.5/- lakhs (Rupees Five lakhs only) in the University as an endowment and this has been deposited in the State Bank of Mysore, Mysore, University Campus Branch.
2. The University shall open a separate account in a scheduled bank and deposit the endowment amount, alongwith the already accumulated interest.
3. During each financial year, the interest accrued on the endowment shall be made use of for the following items of expenditure, honorarium of Visiting Professor, Fellowship to the Research Fellows to meet the travelling expenses to and fro, publication of lectures delivered during the term as Visiting Professor in the University, for conducting Seminars / Study Circles, Stationery and local transportation.
4. Any unspent balance during a particular financial year shall be added to the corpus.
5. Excess expenditure, if any, over and above the interest amount earned, shall be met from out of the University funds.

TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT

1. These statutes shall be called as Amendments to the Statutes relating to Tenure of appointment of Visiting Professor under Swamy Vivekananda Chair.
2. These Statutes shall come into effect from the date of assent of the chancellor.
